Principal's News: September is a wonderful time in the school year. By the time September begins, students and teachers have created their new classroom community together, gotten to know each other, and had time to practice routines and learn expectations. September is also the time when we have specific time set aside for parents/guardians to meet with their child's teacher to discuss initial progress and goals for the year. Communication between school and home is extremely important. Families should be hearing from their child's teacher at least once a week about what is going on in the classroom, homework/projects, and what is coming up. If you are not hearing from your child's teacher weekly, please reach out to your child's teacher to let them know you are not receiving their weekly communication or call the office. Also, please make sure your email and phone number are always up to date in ParentVue. Thank you for continuing to send your child to school with a water bottle. Please, **WATER only** in water bottles! No Gatorade, juice, soda, energy drinks, or caffeinated drinks are allowed in the classroom or playground. Please do not send your child to school with anything other than water in their water bottle. For lunch, juice or flavored water are welcome, but please do not send your child to school with soda or caffeinated drinks. Friendly reminder that we have 4 filtered water stations around school for students to refill when needed.
